Fostering Growth



- Early career Talent Development (TD) professionals want to formalize and recognize their role with a certification.
- A growing number of professionals are "accidental trainers" who want to deepen their skills.
- The biggest gap between skills needed and skills possessed was in Learning
 Technologies.
- Having a Global Mindset combines an openness to different cultures and enables TD professionals to see common patterns and appreciate differences.

- Current APTD's
 - 50% have 3-5 years experience
 - 32% had 6-10 years of experience
- Focus:
 - 37% Training Delivery
 - 26% Instructional Design
 - 14% Managing Learning
- Passing Score: 70%

Eligibility Requirements for the APTD

Option 1

3 years of experience in TD or other related discipline

Option 2

2 years of experience in TD or other related disciplines <u>and</u> successful completion of 1 ATD Masters program (Master Trainer or Instructional Designer)



50% Rule is in effect for both options


Assessment-Based Certificates






APTD Exam Windows in 2018
